It's time for the Courtyard Homes HOA Annual Meeting. It will be held at the **Premier Clubhouse** on **Thursday October 18, 2012 at 7:00 P.M.** Please mark your calendars. This year's meeting will feature changes in the budget for 2012 based on new charges that have been levied. There are also questions and suggestions that have been made during the year that we need to address.

The holiday season is fast approaching, so please adhere to the instructions on displaying Flags and Decorations. All Holiday decorations, including external lights shall be permitted for a period beginning 10 days prior to the Holiday and must be removed no later than 5 days after the Holiday. This includes Halloween and Thanksgiv-

ing. For the Christmas holiday, you may display decorations beginning on Thanksgiving and must be removed by January 15, 2013. Please see the Public Offering Statement (POS) in the Rules and Regulations section Paragraph #19.

This is also an Election year, so please follow the rules regarding electioneering and candidate placards and signage. Basically the POS states that 'Vote For' signage can only be displayed on the inside of windows and kept to 20 inches by 30 inches. No placards and/or signage are to be placed on the outside of homes, in the mulch, on lawns, and in the Common Areas
