Master Association Notes

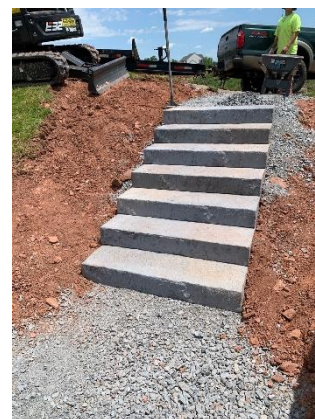
Revised Guidance for the Pool and Community Center:

Although we are in the Green phase of the Governor's plan to combat the COVID-19 virus, it does not signal the end of the crisis. We urge residents to continue to practice social distancing from people they do not live with and, if that is not possible, residents should wear a mask to limit the spread of the virus.

The MA Board has revised guidance for use of our facilities (i.e., pool and community center) including: limiting the number of people using the gym or community center at any one time to 50% of their capacity and modified pool rules to limit use to residents and nonresident family members only.

Safety Repairs & New Items:

1. The deck around the community center has been shored up by replacing several joists and adding additional hangers.
2. New lighting has been added to illuminate the handicap spaces by the pool as well as additional lighting has been added to the stairs entering the community center.
3. Two pole lights are currently being installed along the cart path from the parking spaces to the community center.
4. Stairs near the tot lot to access the pool and tot lot have been completed. Grass and railings will be installed after July 4. (see photo)

We researched the COVID-19 phased reopening of our State to open the pool in a safe and effective manner. Many hours were spent by the Master Board, our pool contractor, the PA Labs, our State of Pennsylvania point of contact, our lawyer, insurance company and

several of our residents. It was truly a community effort and we thank them for ensuring the safety and comfort of our residents and their families.

The community voted to have no lifeguard this year. Therefore, we would like to remind residents to be extra diligent while swimming and overseeing family members.

We have replaced a pool light and also fixed the lights around the perimeter of the pool. Since the large refurbishment last year, little was needed to be done this year. We have purchased a new grill and two umbrellas. Please note that it is important that you close umbrellas when not in use.

On August 1, 2020, the family committee will be hosting a party at the pool between 4 and 7pm for residents and up to 10 nonresident family member guests per household. Please contact Anna Domzalski for details.

LADIES BOOK CLUB

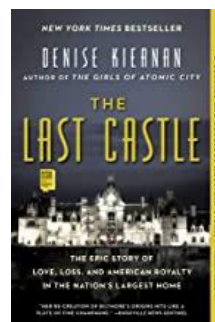
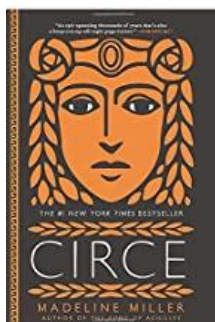
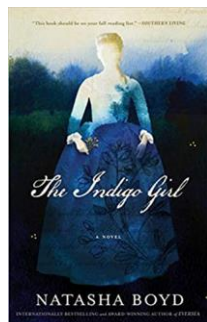
